## PLANNING YOUR WEDDING

This policy should help you plan your wedding at Christ Presbyterian Church. If you have questions about these guidelines or related issues please call the church office at 219 663-0129.

### **Church Membership**

You may be married at Christ Presbyterian Church regardless of your current church membership. However either the bride or the groom must be a Christian: trusting God's gracious mercy, acknowledging Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and seeking to be a faithful disciple of Jesus Christ.

### **Time**

We will place your wedding and rehearsal on the Church calendar as soon as you provide a completed application and schedule your first counseling session.

### **Place**

Most weddings will be performed in the Church Sanctuary. If another location is desired these arrangements can be discussed with the pastor when you schedule your initial pre-marital counseling session. There is no charge for use of the sanctuary for members and their families. Non-members are charged a fee to cover janitorial expenses, utilities, and maintenance.

### **Pre-marital Counseling**

The pastor will meet with all couples desiring to be married for pre-marital counseling. These sessions will consist of: discussions about the meaning, privileges, and responsibilities of Christian marriage; a review of the marriage ceremony and the vows; and an exploration of the married life in relationship to discipleship and the Church. These topics will be covered in three 1-hour sessions. Whenever possible these sessions should begin several months before the wedding. You should also meet with the pastor a month or so after the ceremony.

An honorarium may be given to the pastor in recognition of time preparing for and providing counseling sessions, the rehearsal, and the wedding ceremony.

### *Rehearsal*

Most weddings require a rehearsal. This is traditionally held the day before the ceremony. The bride and groom, their attendants, the organist and any soloists, ushers, and parents should be in attendance.

### *Music*

The church organist will serve at all church weddings unless other arrangements are made by the couple. Musical selections will be discussed with the pastor during pre-marital counseling to ensure that the proper religious focus is maintained. The organist fee includes these services:

- A short meeting to discuss and select music.
- Any music to be performed by the musician must be given to the musician, if not the musician's collection. The musician observes all copyright laws in the reproduction of music.
- The music must be given to the musician no later than two weeks before the wedding, otherwise the musician may select substitute music.
- Two half-hour practices with the soloist(s) – one before the rehearsal and the other at the rehearsal.
- Music at the wedding rehearsal.
- Fifteen minutes of prelude music, procession pieces, and postlude music.
- Accompaniment for up to 2 solo or duet vocal pieces.

### *Flowers*

You may secure flowers from any source of your choice. Make arrangements to have the flowers and any other decorations delivered at least one hour before the service. The placement of flowers in the sanctuary will take place with the consultation of the

pastor. The wedding party is responsible for the disposal of all floral arrangements and decorations following the service. If desired the flowers may be donated for Sunday worship; if you let us know at least a week in advance, your donation will be noted in the bulletin.

### **Photographs**

The congregation may take pictures during the processional and the recessional. The movement of photographers may disturb you, your guests, and the pastor during the worship service. Your wedding service may be photographed or videotaped only from the rear of the sanctuary using a fixed tripod and only with existing lighting (no flash photography).

No other picture taking is permitted during the actual wedding ceremony. Photography requiring special lighting or staging maybe conducted before the prelude or after the recessional.

### **Candles**

The church has two candelabra that may be used, each holds seven candles. There is a fee for the dripless candle fuel.

### **Final Things**

- Please use birdseed instead of rice, its better for God's little creatures. Also refrain from throwing birdseed inside of the church.
- Limited facilities are available in which the wedding party may dress.
- The marriage license must given to the pastor prior to the wedding rehearsal.
